Meeting Notes:

The meeting was opened at 4:00 PM by Mr. S. Van Hoozer (Chairman) with a prayer and an additional devotional for the Team, encouraging them to be still and to rely on God to guide them through the challenges we will face.

1. REVIEW OF THE COLUMBAIUM LAYOUT

Ms. Y. Bell presented a new proposal for a unique design which includes a labyrinth. Represented by *untitled drawing (PDF file dwg Scan 2018 9-26)*.

This design was reviewed by the Team and compared to previous designs that have been reviewed in prior meetings.

Ms. Bell will follow up with Mr. David Curry to obtain a cost estimate for the proposed design.

2. REVIEW OF THE PROPOSED DESIGN OF THE MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM

The Team reviewed the proposed design details of the Multi-Purpose Room.

The requirements included:

- A designated closet (size approximately 4 x 5") to be used by the Senior Adult Ministry.
- Sufficient storage/ closet space to store the anticipated number of tables and chairs that will be used by the room. This will allow the full size of the room to be used for other purposes (other than seated), if required.
- The potential for a "U"-shaped kitchenette located on the wall which will be used for the above-mentioned storage.

3. REVIEW OF THE PROPOSED DESIGN OF THE NARTHEX REMOLDEL

The Team reviewed the proposed design details of the Multi-Purpose Room.

The requirements included:

- Adding a coffee bar in the southwest corner of the Narthex.
- Providing plenty of comfortable chairs and sofas for use by the Congregation.
- Providing some tables and chair as space permits.

4. PROJECT PRESENTATION TO CONGREGATION (3rd IMPRESSION MEETINGS)

The "*Third Impression Meetings*" with the Congregation occurred as scheduled on 9/22-23/18 after the Saturday service and between the Sunday morning services.

The purpose of these meetings was to review the refinements to the project plan that have occurred in the past few months with the Congregation, prior to the Kick Off of the Capital Campaign scheduled for the first part of October.

These meeting were very well received and showed strong support from the Congregation. Several insightful questions were asked about finances and prioritization of the project. At this time the Team has decided to postpone prioritization discussions until the results of the Capital Campaign are known.

Pastor S. Whites encouraged the Team to proceed in faith, trusting that God will provide for the needs of the Church.

5. FINANCES

The Capital campaign is scheduled to begin October 5th. Preparations for the Campaign are ongoing.

Mr. D. Lupton provided information on the financial stability of the Church and the ability of the Church to fund a portion of the costs from its own resources.

6. TIMING & UPCOMING EVENTS

- The next team meeting will be Oct 8th @ 4PM, Room S-1.
- Church Conference review of the project will be conducted in November 2018
- The Architect (Kinney Franke) will continue to provide detailed drawings so the Contractor can begin to provide detailed plans for the project.

The Meeting was adjourned at 5:00PM with a prayer from Mr. D White.
